Snohomish County Memorial at Noon, June 11th for President Reagan

Snohomish County citizens and employees are invited to attend a ceremony commemorating the life of President Ronald Reagan at noon on Friday June 11th. The ceremony, on the plaza on the Wall Street side of the county courthouse, will include a moment of silence for the former President, remembrances by three county elected officials, and patriotic hymns by the Overman Family Singers.

Remembrances will be given by Snohomish County Sheriff Rick Bart, Superior Court Judge David Hulbert, and County Council Chair John Koster. The Overman Family Singers from Arlington will perform and lead the crowd in patriotic hymns. The ceremony will conclude with Kyle Miller of Snohomish High School playing taps as the US flag on the courthouse plaza is posted at half-staff and the crowd is led in the singing of America the Beautiful.

On Wednesday the county council and executive, in a joint resolution, declared Snohomish County's desire to join in the national day of mourning for President Reagan.
