Open Tue 10AM-6PM, Wed and Thur 9AM-5PM. \$10 For walk-in pregnancy tests. Free Teen Clinics 2nd & 4th Thur ea. Month 1:30-4 PM.

Birth control, Emergency Contraception, Take Charge applications available Planned Parenthood clinics accept medical coupons. Funds available for people with no medical insurance, including undocumented women and men. Spanish Speaking receptionist.

Open Mon-Fri. Services as above, except NO funding for non-citizens. Free Teen Clinics 2nd & 4th Thur ea. Month 1-4 PM.

Emergency Contraception Hotline-1-888-NOT-2-LATE for closest place to get EC. Emergency Contraception is covered by women who have medical coupons.

Emergency Contraception Without a Prescription

All **Fred Meyers, Walgreens, Top Foods**. Planned Parenthoods also, but they'll need to spend some time with you. All above accept medical coupons, private insurance, and cash. For other locations, call EC Hotline. If no medical coupon or private insurance, cost is usually \$45-60.

Take Charge- Birth control and reproductive health program for men and women at or below 200% Federal Poverty Level, who don't currently have health insurance, medical coupons, or medical coverage that includes family planning benefits. It doesn't cover abortions. **All Planned Parenthood Clinics are Take Charge Providers and have the applications.** For more information call the **Family Planning Hotline# at: 1-800-770-4334**
