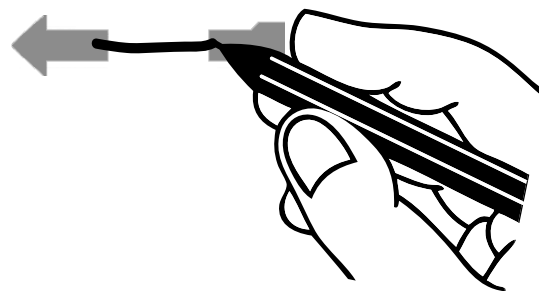
Use a single line to mark your vote.

#### Initiative Measure No. 1125

Initiative Measure No. 1125 concerns state expenditures on transportation. Restoring Property Tax Levy Rate

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 4 adopted Resolution No. 455 to finance fire protection and other services. This proposition would allow the District to restore its regular tax levy rate to its previously authorized limit of \$1.50 per \$1,000 assessed value in 2012; and authorize an annual increase of up to 6% (not to exceed a rate of \$1.50) for each of the five succeeding years through 2017, but would not authorize an excess levy.
