

Marriage License General Information

Marriages may be performed anywhere within the State of Washington by justices of the supreme court, judges of the court of appeals and superior court, superior court commissioners, any regularly licensed or ordained minister or priest of any church or religious denomination or judges of courts of limited jurisdiction.

No Witnesses or Blood Test Required to Obtain a Marriage License

Marriage License is Void if Not Solemnized within 60 Days of the Application Date

Licenses will not be issued on Saturdays, Sundays or Holidays.

Application Instructions USE BLACK INK ONLY

Both parties, bride and groom, must sign the application before a notary public or deputy auditor. The marriage license will be given to the parties upon application. **The license is not valid (cannot be used) until the third full day after the application is filed.** For example, if the application is made on Monday, the first day it can be used is Thursday. The 3 day waiting period cannot be waived under any circumstance including court order.

Application By Mail

If applying by mail, please submit at least 30 days prior to ceremony to ensure sufficient processing and return mail time.

Money Orders or Cashier Checks Only
Make payable to Snohomish County Auditor
No Personal Checks Accepted

Please include a contact name, address and phone number where you may be reached during the day if necessary.

Age Requirements

Legal age for both groom and bride is **18** years old. Witnesses or blood tests are not required to obtain a marriage license in the State of Washington.

17 Year Olds

One parent or legal guardian must accompany the under aged applicant and sign the marriage application form granting consent. Parent must have authority to consent to marriage. Legal guardians must provide original or a certified copy of the legal guardianship documents.

16 Year Olds or Younger

Applicants must have the consent of Superior Court. In Snohomish County, please contact Family Court Services at 425-388-3140.

The marriage license is void if the marriage is not performed within 60 days of the application date.
