

# Eligibility Criteria for SCSO Community Corrections Programs

## WORK EDUCATION AND RELEASE PROGRAM (WER)

### Statutory Criteria:

- ❖ Sentenced felony and misdemeanor offenders
- ❖ Community Custody
- ❖ Participation in Work Release shall be conditioned upon the offender attending work or school at regularly defined hours and abiding by the rules of the Work Release facility

### Program Criteria:

- ❖ Class C & Class D Felony Offenses
- ❖ Class B Felony Offences which are non-violent
- ❖ No sex offenders unless ordered by the court
- ❖ Sentenced between 10 and 365 days per charge
- ❖ No history of felony domestic violence
- ❖ Employed 24 hours or more per week or attending school,
- ❖ Non-violent offenders
- ❖ **Services:**
  - ✓ In house Offender Change programs
  - ✓ Random breathalyzer and urinalysis testing
  - ✓ Case supervision
  - ✓ Daily contact with offender
  - ✓ Monitored program schedules

## WORK PROGRAM (OFFENDER WORK CREW)

### Statutory Criteria:

- ❖ Community Custody Violators
- ❖ No Sex offenders

### Program Criteria:

- ❖ No current or past history of domestic violence (two or more DV convictions within last 5 years)
- ❖ No sex offenders
- ❖ Non-violent offenders
- ❖ Basic phone service and stable residence if home monitoring is ordered.
- ❖ GPS available if basic phone service is unavailable
- ❖ Stable Residence
- ❖ Physically able to work
- ❖ Pre-sentenced and Sentenced male and female felony and misdemeanant offenders
- ❖ Drug Court Violators
- ❖ **Services:**
  - ✓ Perform physical labor for County agencies
  - ✓ Daily contact with offender
    - a) Random breathalyzer and urinalysis testing

## HOME DETENTION WITH ELECTRONIC MONITORING (EHD)

### The following offenses are statutorily prohibited from EHD:

- ❖ A violent offense (RCW 9.94A.030)
- ❖ A drug offense (RCW 9.94A.030)
- ❖ A sex offense (RCW 9.94A.030)
- ❖ Reckless burning in the first or second degree
- ❖ Assault of a child 3<sup>rd</sup> degree
- ❖ Assault 3<sup>rd</sup> degree
- ❖ Unlawful imprisonment
- ❖ Harassment
- ❖ Superior Court felony charges must maintain employment, attend school, or perform child care for children in their custody, presence needed at home; medical conditions;

- ❖ **EHD may be imposed for offenders convicted of:**
- ❖ PCS under RCW 69.50.403
- ❖ Forged Prescription for a controlled substance under RCW 69.50.403
- ❖ Community Custody Violators

### Program Criteria:

- ❖ **No Current or History of Domestic Violence** (two or more DV convictions within last 5
- ❖ Pre-sentenced and Sentenced male and female felony and misdemeanor offenders
- ❖ Basic phone service and stable residence if home monitoring is ordered.

- ❖ GPS available if basic phone service is unavailable
- ❖ In the last stage of Jail or Work Release sentence
- ❖ May be used with Work Program
- ❖ **Services:**
  - ✓ Case supervision
  - ✓ Random breathalyzer and urinalysis testing
  - ✓ Electronically monitored 24 hours
  - ✓ Immediate notification of tampering
  - ✓ Alcohol Monitoring
  - ✓ GPS
  - ✓ Scalable Payment Program
