County again among nation's most tech-savvy

Snohomish County has again been ranked one of the nation's most technologically-advanced, cutting-edge county governments.

The Center for Digital Government and the National Association of Counties ranked Snohomish County fifth nationally in its prestigious 2007 Digital Counties Survey. The survey is an annual study by the Center and the National Association of Counties (NACo).

“The survey validates our effort to deliver efficient, expanded online customer service,” Executive Reardon said.

Online Snohomish County public services include:

- Advanced mapping services
- Property assessment and tax information
- Building and mechanical permits
- Court services and trial calendars
- Registered sex offender information
- Public records search.

The County ranked ninth in the 2006 survey.

In April, thousands of US counties were invited to participate in the 2007 Digital Counties Survey. County officials responded to survey questions that included more than 100 measurements and data points about online service delivery, infrastructure, architecture and governance models.

Counties were grouped into three population categories. Snohomish County was ranked in highest population category, 500,000 or more.

The awards were presented at the July 13-17 NACo annual conference in Richmond, Virginia.
