Cross-Systems 101 Training Day: Eliminating Barriers to Services

Increasing Accessibility to our Systems through Community Outreach and Education

On May 3, 2007, the Snohomish County Office of Children's Affairs in partnership with the Juvenile Courts will conduct **Cross-Systems 101 Training Day**, seminar beginning at 8:00am, at New Life Four Square Church, 6830 Highland Dr., Everett.

The training, for families and social service professionals, will offer instruction on access to Snohomish County's Juvenile Courts, Mental Health, and the Department of Child and Family Services (DCFS) systems.

County Executive Aaron Reardon said, "Helping families to connect faces with names, services and program access enables the County to make our systems more transparent and user-friendly."

The sessions will allow participants a departure from the one-size-fits-all approaches and feature a choice of workshops hosted by co-sponsoring community-based agencies.

Juvenile Court and DCFS will co-present their services over a working lunch.

More than 15 participating agencies will operate tables and provide resource/reference.
