COUNTY “DAYS OF CARING” VOLUNTEER PROJECTS

County Executive Aaron Reardon today announced two Snohomish County sponsored activities in support of United Way “Days of Caring.”

“This is a great opportunity to volunteer community service,” Executive Reardon said. “Snohomish County wants to make a significant difference in service delivery to County families, children and seniors.”

Each year, United Way’s “Days of Caring” brings together local agencies, businesses and volunteers in community wide support activities.

Executive Reardon says two volunteer efforts will occur in Snohomish County Parks on the “Days of Caring”:

- On **September 28, 2007, 9:30a.m.-2:00 p.m. at Meadowdale County Park, 15433 75th Pl. W., Edmonds (parking at upper lot - 6026 156th SW)**, 72 volunteers from Snohomish County Surface Water Management; People for Puget Sound; Edmonds Community College Anthropology Department; and Washington State University Extension Office Beach Watchers will plant 350 native plants and remove non-native vegetation.
- On **September 29, 2007, 9a.m.-2 p.m. at Willis Tucker Community Park, 6705 Puget Park Drive, Snohomish**, United Way of Snohomish County volunteers will build a “Born Learning Trail” and erect educational and interpretive signage.

Last year, according to United Way, 1,000 volunteers throughout Snohomish County donated their time, supplies and their power of compassion to complete over 65 “Days of Caring” projects.
