Executive Reardon Cuts Ribbon on New Lundeen Park Way Extension Project

Snohomish County Executive Aaron Reardon, today, cut the ribbon officially opening the new Lundeen Park Way extension to through-traffic.

“Completion of the Lundeen Park Way is a major milestone in our county wide campaign to improve road safety and travel time in our fastest growing communities,” said Reardon.

The new \$12.5 million Lundeen Park Way Extension is the final link in a comprehensive road system in the Frontier Village area of Lake Stevens. The entire road system was built in four phases over a 14-year period of time at a total cost of \$18 million.

Funding for the Lundeen Park Way Extension project included \$2 million in grant money from the State Transportation Improvement Board, \$7.7 million in county road funds and about \$3 million from local developers.

The Lundeen Park Way extension is located west at Highway 9 and connects to Highway 204 to the south.

“It’s a win for both residents and the local economy,” said Reardon. “Local residents gain direct access to Frontier Village, and travel time on SR-9 is improved making it easier for local businesses to draw customers.”

Specific transportation design elements include:

- Extension and wider travel corridor the entire length between SR9 and SR 204.
- Includes one vehicle lane in each direction, a center turn lane, bike lanes, sidewalks, curbs and gutters.
- A new bridge across a tributary to Weiser Creek.
- New traffic signals and wider intersections.

- Enclosed drainage and four water quality detention ponds.
