## **Reardon names Larry Calter to lead Department of Information Services**

Snohomish County Executive Aaron Reardon announced today he is appointing Larry Calter as the new Director of the Department of Information Services.

Calter comes to Snohomish County from King County Metro Transit where he was the IT Manager. While at Metro, Calter provided strategic leadership to all aspects of Information Systems and managed \$200 million in capital programs.

“Larry is committed to delivering world-class technology systems that will make County services easier and more accessible to the public,” Reardon said. “His experience developing and implementing innovative solutions will make him a valuable asset to our organization.”

The Department of Information Services builds, supports and operates the County’s technological backbone. The Department provides technology development and support services vital to the efficient operation of Snohomish County government. These services include development of web services, imaging and records management, technical support, Geographical Information Systems (GIS) mapping and development and maintenance of internal technology services.

Calter, who will join Snohomish County on December 3, said on Thursday, “I’m excited to join a team at Snohomish County that is committed to using technology to make services more efficient and customer-friendly.”

Prior to joining King County Metro, Calter was a Program Manager for T-Mobile and Director of Information Technology for CONVERSAY, Inc. in Bellevue. Calter has a Master’s Degree in Management of Information Technology from The George Washington University and a Bachelor’s Degree in Management and Computer Science from the University of Maryland.
