Executive's choice for DIS director confirmed

Executive Aaron Reardon's choice for director of Snohomish County's Information Services Department was unanimously confirmed Monday by the County Council.

Calter joined the county in early December, following his position as IT manager at King County Metro Transit. While at Metro, Calter provided strategic leadership on information systems development and managed a \$200 million capital program.

"We knew Larry would provide experience developing and implementing innovative solutions within our organization, and we're glad the County Council agrees," Reardon said. "With the confirmation behind us, we can continue delivering world-class technology systems that will make county services easier and more accessible to the public."

The Department of Information Services (DIS) creates, supports and operates the County's technological backbone. The department provides technology development and support services vital to the efficient operation of Snohomish County government. These services include development of Web-based programs, imaging and records management, technical support, Geographical Information Systems (GIS) mapping and development and maintenance of internal technology services.

"I am extremely excited to be here," Calter said. "I look forward to working with the DIS team to provide world-class customer service to the citizens and government of Snohomish County."

Prior to joining King County Metro, Calter was a program manager for T-Mobile and director of information technology for Conversay in Bellevue.

Calter has a master's degree in management of information technology from The George Washington University and a bachelor's degree in management and computer science from the University of Maryland.
