Snohomish County DUI Victims to be Remembered

Ceremonial unveiling of Eight Victims Tiles at DUI Memorial Wall

On Thursday, June 15th, 2006 at 1:30 p.m., Snohomish County Executive Aaron Reardon and members of the Snohomish County DUI Task Force will unveil tiles for eight DUI victims who are being commemorated on the DUI Victims Memorial Wall. The unveiling ceremony will take place at McCollum Park (near the pool). The address is 600-128th Street, Everett.

“Remembering those who have lost their lives to this senseless, preventable tragedy, is very important,” says Executive Reardon, “It reminds us of the need to be relentless in our pursuit and prosecution of DUI criminals.”

The Snohomish County DUI Victims Memorial Wall is the first in Washington State. The initial unveiling of 45 tiles on the DUI Victims Memorial Wall took place on July 19, 2001. With this 6th unveiling, the front of the Wall will include 108 County DUI victims.
