Citizens asked for input on new community park

Snohomish County is seeking input from citizens on the design of a new community park located to the east of Bothell.

Residents, especially those living near 228th Street Southeast and 45th Avenue Southeast, are encouraged to attend a public meeting April 22 to discuss the future of 12 acres acquired with funding provided by King County as mitigation for the Brightwater sewage-treatment plant.

This site is planned for community park development and will include a mix of recreation opportunities designed to serve area residents. Residents are asked to provide input into the types of recreational facilities that are needed and could be located in the park.

Snohomish County is spending about \$2.7 million on the 12 acres. This is the first Parks acquisition funded by Brightwater money with another site pending. Additional properties are being evaluated and may be acquired as well.

The public meeting will be from 6:30 to 8 p.m. and will be held at the Snohomish County Parks Office, located at the Willis D. Tucker Community Park, 6705 Puget Park Dr., Snohomish, WA 98296.
