### **Willis Tucker Park sounds off with Shakespeare, concerts**

Snohomish County Parks and Recreation's free Summer Sundays' series begins July 19 with Shakespeare in the Park's "Taming of the Shrew."

Each Sunday between July 19 and Aug. 23, Willis Tucker Community Park, 6705 Puget Park Drive, Snohomish, will be the location for a free Sunday of Shakespeare or music concert.

- Aug. 16 - Alma Villegas and Band Latin Rhythms, 5-7 p.m.
- Aug. 23 - Valhalla Hill Indie/Folk Rock Music, 5-7 p.m.
