H1N1 vaccine for low-income, high-risk folks

Snohomish Health District increases opportunities for shots

SNOHOMISH COUNTY, Wash. – The Snohomish Health District is expanding its clinic appointments effective immediately to accommodate individuals who have fallen on hard times – no money, no health insurance, no doctor or are on Medicaid – and who also fall into the groups most at risk of complications from H1N1 illness:

- Pregnant women;
- People who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age;
- Health care and emergency medical services personnel;
- Persons ages 6 months through 24 years;
- People ages 25 through 64 years with chronic health conditions or weakened immune systems.

Posters titled “Hard times?” are going up in food banks, libraries and community service agencies throughout Snohomish County to promote the enhanced access to H1N1 vaccine at the Snohomish Health District’s two locations. The special clinics are planned to continue through December.

The health district’s appointment call center will be open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. It will be closed weekends and for the Thanksgiving holiday (Nov. 26-27).
