Stilly Flood Control District Rep Reappointed To County's Ag Board

County Executive Aaron Reardon has announced the appointment of Max Albert to represent the Stillaguamish Flood Control District for a second term on the Snohomish County Agricultural Advisory Board.

"Our ag lands are one of Snohomish County's great treasures," Reardon said. "I am so grateful to these dedicated volunteers who give their time and expertise to benefit the whole county."

In a letter supporting Albert's nomination, the district's commissioners wrote to the Snohomish County Council, "Max has done an excellent job of representing the constituents of the Flood Control District and farmers in the county." Appointments are recommended by the County Executive and confirmed by the Council.

The board, consisting of 13 members, advises and makes recommendations to county officials on agricultural conservation. One position is for a representative of the Stillaguamish Flood Control District. Albert is the district's project manager for the Old Channel project, and his family owns two farms in the Stillaguamish Valley. His new term on the Agricultural Advisory Board expires May 20, 2007. Albert also is vice chair of the Snohomish County Farm Bureau.
