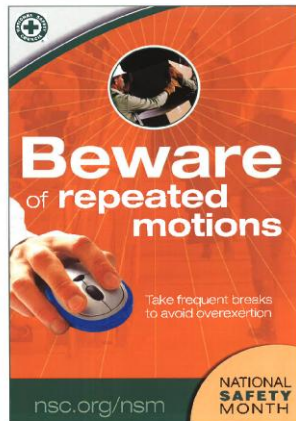
JUNE is NATIONAL SAFETY MONTH

- Overexertion is the third leading cause of unintentional injuries in the United States.



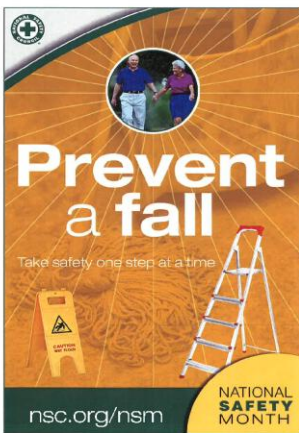
June 12-18:

- Each day there are more than 15 crashes involving drivers between the ages of 15 and 20.



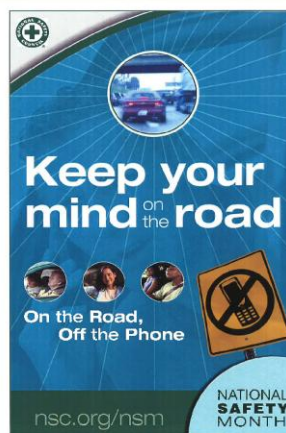
