### OVERVIEW OF COUNCIL ON AGING:

1. Function of Council: Serves in an advisory capacity to the Office of Long Term Care & Aging, Snohomish County Human Services Department, and the County Executive. The Council members serve as advocates for the elderly, disabled, and recipients of long term care services in Snohomish County.
2. The Council on Aging meets once per month on the last Wednesday of each month from 10:00 AM - 12 noon. There is no meeting in December. **In addition to the monthly meetings, members are expected to serve on an additional committee and will probably have at least one additional meeting per month. Please make sure you can make this commitment before applying to the Council.**
3. Council members serve a three-year term and can reapply for one additional consecutive three-year term.
4. It is the policy of the Snohomish County Council on Aging that persons shall not be discriminated against membership on the Council because of race, color, national origin, creed, religion, sex, age, marital status, sexual orientation or disability. The Council on Aging actively encourages members of diverse communities to apply.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The current bylaws of the Snohomish County Council on Aging state: *“Staff or members of a governing board of LTCA contracted service provider agencies may not serve on the Council.”* (Article V – Membership, Section 1.)
