LOCATION: Snohomish County Courthouse, 3000 Rockefeller, Everett. Meet in the Main Lobby.

PAYMENT: **\$40 Fee Payable with Cash**, Cashier's Check or Money Order (no personal checks or debit/credit cards) will be accepted at the door. If you have rescheduled more than once, there will be an additional \$40 fee. No one is admitted without proper payment.

TIME: **Doors Open** at 6:15 p.m. and are locked at 6:30 p.m. Panels begin as soon as registration is completed and last approximately two hours.

NOTE: All attendees must not have had any amount of alcohol/drugs 24 hours prior to attending the DUI Victim Panel. If you smell of alcohol, you will be asked to submit to a breathalyzer test.

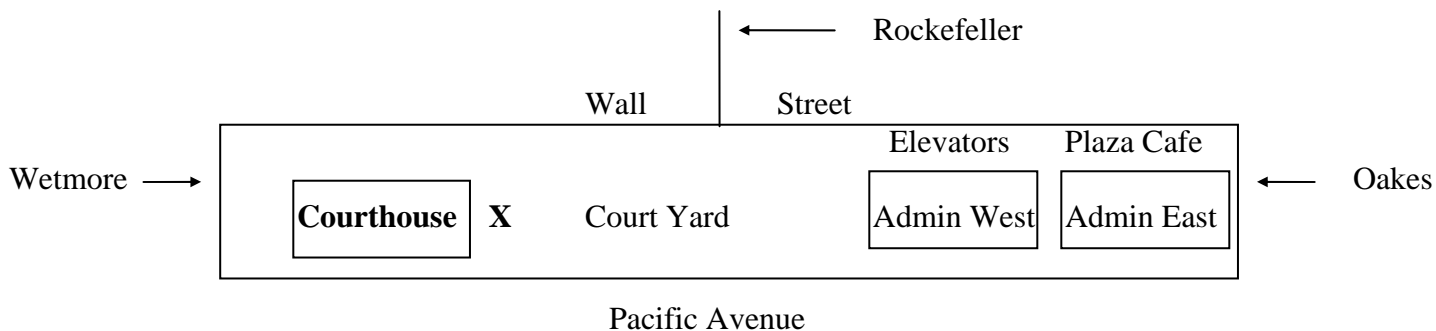

Location: Panels are held at: Snohomish County Courthouse Lobby (by metal detector)
3000 Rockefeller Avenue, Everett, WA 98201



Enter the lobby from the courtyard when admitted by the security guard. You will go through a metal detector so please plan accordingly.

Registration: Registration through your court is preferred unless time is an issue. You can register for an upcoming panel by calling the Victim Panel Voicemail at 425-388-7269.

Fee: **\$40 cash**, money order, or cashier's check will be accepted at the door starting at 6:15 p.m. on the day of your assigned Victim Panel. If you have **rescheduled** more than once, there will be an additional **\$40 fee**. No one is admitted without proper payment. No personal checks or credit/debit cards will be accepted.

Time: Panels run from **6:15 p.m. to 8:45 p.m.** Arrive in plenty of time, as **NO ONE IS ADMITTED AFTER 6:30 P.M.**

Guests: Friends and relatives are welcome, as long as you **DO NOT SIT TOGETHER**. Guests will be asked to sit in the rear of the courtroom as space allows. Children under 12 are not permitted. (No fee is required for guests.)

Paperwork: All Court/Task Force paperwork is mailed to your referring court following your attendance. No paperwork will be distributed at the panel and pink copies will not be signed.

Behavior: (1) You are required to attend straight and sober. If the staff or County Marshall believe you have taken drugs, including alcohol, you will be asked to submit to a breath test and if positive, asked to leave and your court will be notified. (2) You are expected to pay attention throughout the presentations. At specific times you will also be invited to ask questions and make comments. (3) Distracting behavior is not allowed (no eating, drinking, talking to others, etc.) If you are disruptive, you will be asked to leave and your court will be notified.

Credit: You will receive credit for attending as long as you: (1) attend the complete presentation; (2) follow the rules listed above; and (3) fill out all paperwork as requested.
