What is SNOTRAC?

SNOTRAC is the Snohomish County Transportation Coalition.

It is a diverse partnership of human service agencies, transit agencies, school districts, advocacy groups, and people with special transportation needs.

SNOTRAC strives to address the transportation needs of people unable to transport themselves due to a disability, age, or income.



What is SNOTRAC going to do?

Members of SNOTRAC are working together to develop a coordinated transportation system for persons with special transportation needs. SNOTRAC goals are to:

- ★ Increase awareness of transportation options and services
- ★ Simplify trip arrangements
- ★ Build transportation capacity within existing community resources
- ★ Increase transportation options in underserved areas
- ★ Bus Buddy Program for seniors
- ★ Voucher Program for rural travel

What is coordinated transportation?

A coordinated transportation system efficiently uses all local and regional transportation services, including non-traditional ones, to provide user friendly transportation services.

Agencies share resources, facilities, and information in order to help community members easily access the places they need to go.
