

Early Intervention Services

*Develop individualized plans for children ages birth to three who have developmental delays and health concerns.
Provides support to families to enhance each child's development.*

Targeted Outcomes:

- Each family will have access to a Family Resources Coordinator.
- Families will be connected to community resources and receive the support necessary to be a teacher, advocate and decision-maker for their child.
- Families will receive services based on an Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP).
- Federal, state and education dollars are coordinated to provide services for children and families.
- Services will be provided in **natural learning environments**, including the family home, neighborhood or community setting in which children without disabilities participate.
- Families will receive assistance in transitioning into school and community resources at age three.

2009 Monthly Average Outcomes

99% of the children received services in **natural environments**
An average of 550 children/families received early intervention services a month
