\*From I-5, merge onto Hwy 2 East in Everett, \*Take the WA-204 E/20<sup>th</sup> SE exit on the left toward Lake Stevens, \*Keep right to take the 20<sup>th</sup> St SE ramp, \*Turn slight right onto 20<sup>th</sup> St SE. \*Turn left onto WA-9. (WA-9 is just past 94<sup>th</sup> Dr SE-Holy cross Lutheran Church is on the corner. If you reach 99<sup>th</sup> Ave SE you've gone about 0.1 miles too far)  
\*Turn left onto 4<sup>th</sup> St SE (If you reach Marlet Pt, you've gone about 0.3 miles too far)  
Lake Stevens Early Learning Center is just past 93<sup>rd</sup> Dr SE on your right
