

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETINGS SEEKING COMMENT ON  
HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS

Snohomish County and the City of Everett announce the following public meetings designed to receive comments from interested persons and agencies related to the affordable housing and community development (public services, public facilities, infrastructure, economic development) needs of low-and moderate-income persons in Snohomish County. These meetings are being held to assist the County and the City in developing 2010-2014 Consolidated Plans which will become effective July 2010 and will determine priorities, establish goals, and guide the use of certain federal housing and community development funds. The Housing Authority of Snohomish County (HASCO) and the Everett Housing Authority (EHA), both of which will be preparing their own Five-Year Plans for affordable housing, will co-host these meetings.
