

OFF-LEASH DOG AREA RULES

1. PARK HOURS ARE DAWN TO DUSK. DUSK IS 20 MINUTES AFTER SUNSET.
2. OWNERS OF DOGS IN DESIGNATED OFF-LEASH AREAS MUST BE PRESENT AT ALL TIMES WITHIN VOLCAL CONTROL DISTANCE OF THEIR DOGS, AND ENSURE THAT THEIR DOGS DO NOT CAUSE PUBLIC NUISANCE, SAFETY HAZARD OR HARASS PEOPLE, OTHER DOGS OR WILDLIFE.
3. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES MAY AN OWNER BRING A SICK DOG INTO THE PARK (SEVERE RUNNY NOSE/EYES, DIARRHEA, VOMITING, COUGH, ETC.).
4. YOU ARE REQUIRED BY LAW (S.C.C. 22.16.030) TO SCOOP YOUR PET'S WASTE.
5. PARK VISITORS USE THE PARK AT THEIR OWN RISK. OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE AND LIABLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN, DOGS AND THEIR ACTIONS. LEAVING DOGS OR CHILDREN UNATTENDED IS PROHIBITED.
6. LIMIT OF THREE (3) DOGS PER ADULT.
7. DOGS SHALL BE ON LEASH IN ALL AREAS OF THE PARK OUTSIDE THE DESIGNATED OFF-LEASH AREAS.
8. OWNERS SHALL CARRY A LEASH AND MONITOR THEIR DOG'S AT ALL TIMES.
9. DOGS IN HEAT SHALL BE LEFT AT HOME.
10. DOGS THAT EXHIBIT DANGEROUS OR AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR; INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO BITING AND FIGHTING SHALL BE LEASHED IMMEDIATELY, AND REMOVED FROM THE PARK; AND MAY BE ASKED NOT TO RETURN TO THE OLDA.
11. DOGS WITH A HISTORY OF DANGEROUS BEHAVIOR ARE PROHIBITED.
12. PUPPIES LESS THAN FOUR (4) MONTHS OF AGE ARE PROHIBITED.
13. EXCESSIVE BARKING OR DIGGING SHALL BE CONTROLLED AS A COURTESY TO OTHER PARK VISITORS. OWNERS SHALL FILL HOLES PRIOR TO LEAVING PARK.
14. CALL 911 FOR ALL EMERGENCIES. CALL SNOHOMISH COUNTY PARK RANGERS AT 360-568-2274 TO REPORT ANY DOG AGGRESSION OR ATTACKS.
15. UNTIL RUNNING WATER BECOMES AVAILABLE, OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING DRINKING WATER FOR THEIR CANINE COMPANIONS. IN ORDER TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF ILLNESS, PLEASE DO NOT SHARE WATER BOWLS WITH OTHER PARK USERS.
16. REFER TO SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE TITLE 9. ANIMALS AND TITLE 22. PARKS FOR ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS. VIOLATION OF PARK RULES OR COUNTY CODES SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE PARKS OFFICE AT (425)388-6600.
