These circular, domed tents traditionally served as shelters for Mongolian nomads and were made of poles covered with felt or animal skins. Today's yurts in the YURT Village at Kayak Point County Park have hardwood floors, electricity, screen windows, skylight, all enclosed in light-colored canvas with a locking door.
