

Vacancies on the Snohomish County Noxious Weed Control Board

Snohomish County is seeking applicants for appointment to the Noxious Weed Control Board in Districts 2, 3, 4 and 5. The Noxious Weed Control Board designs and administers the County's noxious weed control program under the authorization of State law and County policies. The member appointed will take office in 2012 after appointment by the County Executive. Eligible persons must reside in the district in which they are applying for. Terms are 4 years. The districts open are as follows:

District 2

Northern boundary is south of the north line of Sections 7 - 12, Township 31N, running in an east and west direction across the County. The southern boundary is the southern boundary of section 7 - 12; Township 30N running in and east west direction. The area is south of 220th St NE Street and north of 108th St. NE.

District 3

Northern boundary is south of 108th St. NE which is south of all Sections 7 - 12, Township 30N running in an east west direction. The southern boundary is North of 20th St. SE which is north of all Sections 25 - 30, Township 29N, running in an east and west direction. The southern boundary is north of Cavaleros Corner.

District 4

Northern boundary is south of 30th St. SE or south of the north border of Sections 25-30, Township 29N running in an east west direction across the county. The southern boundary is north of 132nd Street and north of the northern boundary of Sections 31 - 36, Township 28N running in an east west direction. The city of Snohomish is located about in the middle of this district.

District 5

Northern Boundary is the northern line of Sections 31 - 36, Township 28N. running east and west across the County. The district is south of 132nd Street. The southern boundary is the King County line.

A written application along with signatures of ten registered voters residing in the same district as described above is required. The Board meets seven times during the year. Meetings are currently held on the second Thursday of February, March, April, May, July, September, and December. Members are compensated for expenses related to their duties.
