

128th St. SW Vicinity Sidewalks



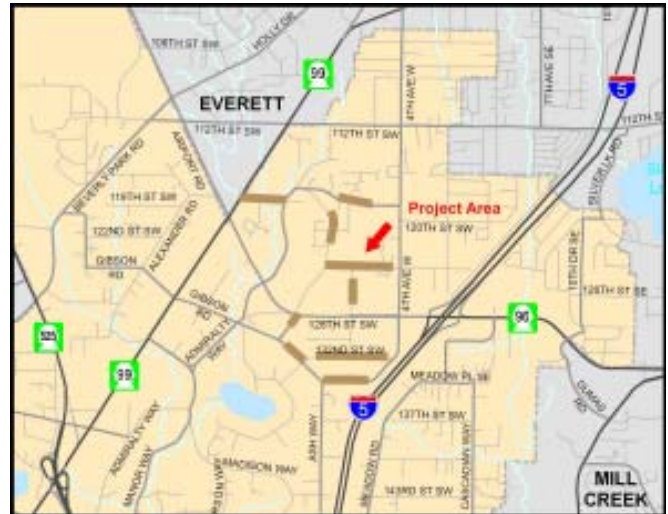
Description

This project includes construction of sidewalks and walkways to fill gaps in the existing facility. New construction will occur in up to 12 locations with substandard or nonexistent portions of the pedestrian facility. Most areas with relatively new improvements will be designed to urban standards with new curb, gutter and sidewalk. In some areas with only existing gravel shoulder, the roadway will be widened to include an interim walkway with the assumption that developer improvements will occur at a later date.

Benefits

Use of CIDI Bonds will expand the number of locations improved with this project. This project will provide a continuous, safe pedestrian network of sidewalks and walkways near and around 128th St SW. This will improve overall safety and mobility in this high density residential and commercial area. The project will greatly improve pedestrian access to multiple bus stops on the local streets including the CT Park and Ride on 4th Avenue West. Ultimately, a safer, continuous facility will reduce the risk of accidents involving pedestrians that historically have occurred in this area.
