Bridge work will close one lane on Mountain Loop Highway

Snohomish County's Granite Falls Bridge #102 spans the South Fork of the Stillaguamish River one and a half miles northeast of Granite Falls along the Mountain Loop Highway. This summer work will begin on preventative maintenance procedures that will include painting, seismic retrofitting, and replacement of expansion joints. The work is weather dependent and may extend into summer 2011.

During the majority of the project one 10-foot wide lane will remain open to all legal loads for alternating traffic. There may be intermittent closures as equipment is moved across the road. Traffic will be controlled by flaggers or a temporary signal. Details are not yet available. Delays should be brief.

Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
