

# Snohomish County Begins Community Improvements in Maltby Area



**D**uring the coming months, Snohomish County will begin work on roadway improvements in your community. The projects are funded by an agreement between King and Snohomish County to mitigate the impacts of the Brightwater Wastewater Treatment Plant. The agreement provides a total of \$70 million for parks, public safety improvements, habitat mitigation and a community resource center. Roads identified for improvements are: 228th Street SE (39th - SR9); and 45th (240th - 212th), 49th (236th - 228th), 53rd (233rd - 228th) and 57th (236th - 228th) Avenues SE.

In December, "Rights-of-entry" letters will be mailed to property owners to seek permission for county surveyors to be on properties adjacent to these roads. The surveyors may place temporary stakes to identify public right-of-way, topographical features and limitations along the edge to the roadways.

## After Survey Information is Gathered

County engineers will design options for pedestrian and bicycling improvements along each road. Once this is done, a public meeting will be held in mid 2008 to give residents an opportunity to speak with project staff, provide comments and suggestions, and see what their neighbors think about the proposals.
