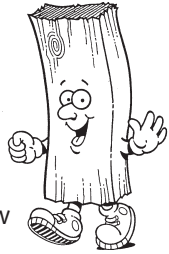


RECYCLING OPTIONS

Wood/Yard Debris Recycling



Snohomish County accepts wood/yard debris for recycling at our Transfer Stations. Please review the following list for what is and is not accepted. (\$45 per ton; \$11 min. up to 500 lbs.) Wood/yard debris recycling is not available at our Neighborhood Recycling & Disposal Centers (NRDCs) but is accepted as regular garbage.

YES (accepted for recycling)

- Grass clippings
- Weeds
- Leaves
- Branches
- Tree stumps
(2 man stump)
- Lumber (must be free of sheetrock/paint)
- Pallets
- Plywood, OSB (unpainted)
- Pressboard (free of laminates)
- Less than 10' long

Recycle these items
in the Yard Waste at
the Transfer stations
as directed

NO (not accepted for recycling)

- No sheetrock or material commingled with sheetrock
- No soil
- No rocks
- No sod
- No food waste
- No pet waste
- No plastic bags or pots
- No chemicals
- No laminates (i.e., formica, linoleum)
- No treated or painted lumber
- No material over 10' long
- No railroad ties

Dispose of these
items appropriately

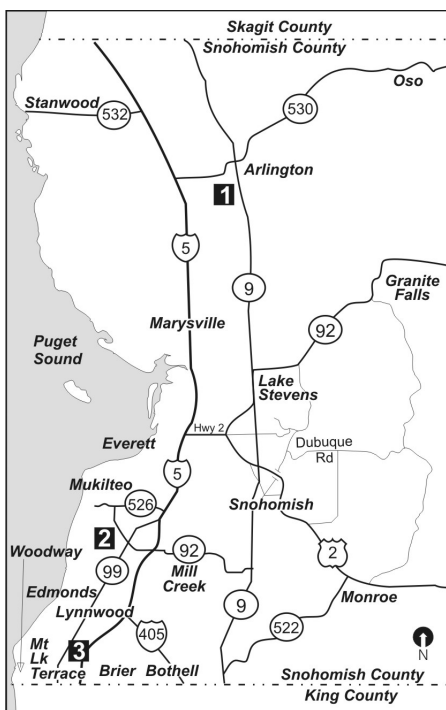
