



See the New FEMA Flood Maps And Get Your Questions Answered

The City of Sultan and Snohomish County will host a public meeting in Sultan to give Skykomish Valley area residents a look at the new Preliminary FEMA flood maps and the changes they incorporate.

The meeting will follow an Open House format, with the County providing a short presentation at 5:45 p.m. Staff members from Snohomish County, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the City of Sultan will be available to answer your questions.

The updated maps are still considered preliminary until formally adopted by the city and county. Residents attending the meeting can learn more about the changes incorporated in the new maps; how the changes will affect flood insurance requirements and building regulations; and the processes for comments and appeals.
