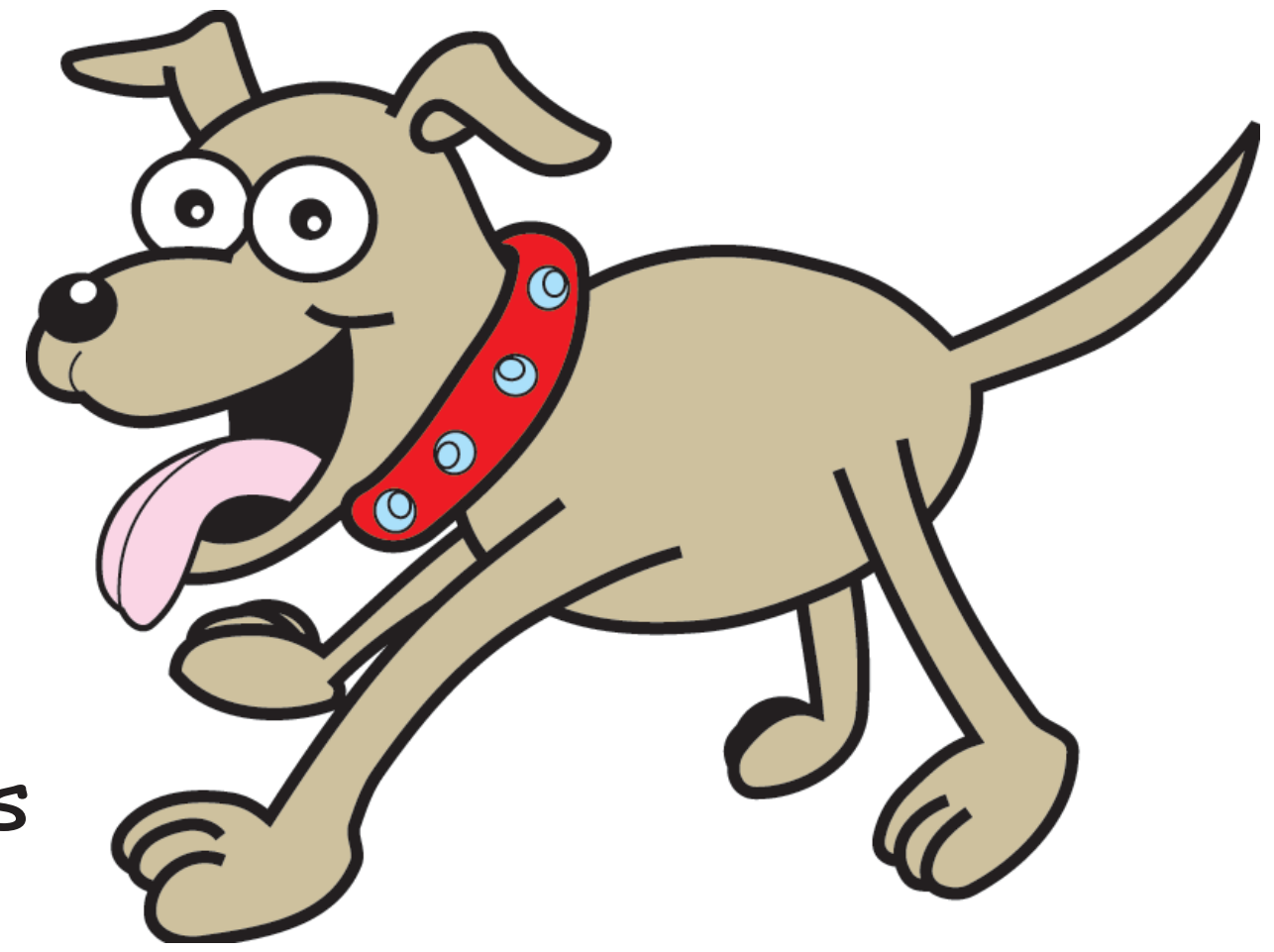


# Dog Poetry
